Brother Darter and some folks from Spring Valley will be coming to Ghana to help us with the organization. God willing, at that time we will also be ordaining Mike Ekpeta. He has proven himself and is an outstanding young man of 28 years. He has finished the Bible College and has been assisting me for two years. His life and conduct is a blessing and it will be a joy to take part in the new step in His ministry. During the past several weeks God has given us many professions. We are thankful.

Francis Cujoe is the father of one of our faithful young ladies. We have prayed for him for more than a year. I have spent hours with him sharing the Word of God. He has been an elder in the Presbyterian Church for years, the head of many of their committees but unsaved and headed for an eternity of torment. We are thankful to have a part in his life and the life of his family. He was saved in his home and scripturally baptized on Sunday, July 3rd.

The Radio Station has been set back some as we must dialogue with the technical representative of the Government which is really not my field. One man who is a Pentecostal deacon has contacted us requesting that training be provided for several of their pastors.
