HAPPY HOLIDAYS

BAPTISMS WE HAVE HAD 10 FOLKS FOLLOW THE LORD IN BAPTISM THIS MONTH.

Many have made professions during the past several weeks but only 18 have made the profession public. Those who are older are often living with someone to whom they are not married. Because of this and the unwillingness to separate until they can follow the laws of Ghana concerning marriage, some do not follow the Lord in scriptural baptism. The village marriages are not recognized by the law and the couple are not considered married until they have registered the marriage with the courts. When they register, then they are required to take their vows either in the court or at the church. We have seen several couples who have been together for many years submit to scriptural marriage. For this we are thankful. However, it takes a serious battle. Folks do not want to admit that they have been living in sin. Most of the churches do not take a stand on this issue. Several have left us because of our stand concerning marriage. On the Word we must stand and stand we will.

THE WOLF ATTACK—As I told you last month, we are having some serious problems in the work. The verbal attacks and even some threats of physical attacks continue. Many have left because of the man and his families' evil intentions. It has been a very difficult seven months. One family was so special to us. There was a baby conceived. The man and woman were not married. I spent time with them and found out that the family of the young woman who had conceived was trying to force her to get an abortion. I also discovered that the young woman had aborted other babies. I did what I could to try and save the baby and God helped us to do so. The little guy was very special to us. Then a little girl came along and they did not even consider an abortion. The father and family were very faithful for several years, but they got caught up in this attack and now they are gone. It is a very painful time.

RADIO BROADCASTS---Our Lord is wonderful and He continues to use His word through the means of radio to reach out to people in the Western and Central Region of Ghana. The testimonies we receive are such a blessing and it is certain that only Heaven will reveal what God has been able to do through your faithful support and the radio ministry. We would like to expand this ministry and add more broadcasts but we are waiting on the Lord to provide the funds for the air time. At this time, we have FM stations that are offering us quality time at a very good price but we are not able to take advantage of the offers. If you would like to help us add broadcast time it would certainly be a blessing. The cost for thirty minutes air time is approximately \$ 35.00 and that does not include the recording and editing expense. If you can help with the cost of a broadcast, weekly, monthly or even one a year, please let us know.
